

## Crandon Park Master Plan Signage Standards Addendum

### Crandon Park Master Plan Adherence

The Crandon Park Master Plan, hereafter referred to as the CPMP, is a detailed document that dictates all activities and elements within Crandon Park. As a Permittee you are required to adhere to the CPMP as it relates to your proposed and approved activities at Crandon Park. The director for the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department authorizes the Crandon Park Manager(s) as his/her designee(s), to enforce all components of the CPMP. A copy of the CPMP is available upon request for review by appointment. Printing services are available at a rate of \$0.15 per page.

### Crandon Park Signage Guidelines and Standards, Section O, page 3

“...there shall be no advertising activity or commercial product advertising or promotional signs, logos or similar devices or appendages displayed or voiced inside or outside of any structure.”

### What this means for your event or activity?

- No signs, banners, flags, balloons, logos, posters, vending machines or any other means of sales or promotion visible from inside or outside of any structure, whether temporary or permanent.
- We allow temporary directional signage to help direct patrons to the approved event or activity in the park; to be set-up no sooner than the day before the event and no later than the day after the event.
- Temporary directional signage may not include the names of any sponsors and must not be placed in such a manner that they obscure any permanent park signs.
- Temporary directional signage may not be affixed or fastened to any park structure whether natural or man-made.
- Temporary directional signage may not include electrical lighting, reflectors, or any moving parts.
