## Univisión to open television studio in Miami

Univisión Communications is creating a new Miami studio to provide the media company with more original content.

The nation's largest Spanish-language media company announced Monday it will start up Univisión Studios in Miami, run by industry veteran Luis Fernandez. The new division will produce telenovelas, reality shows and other programs for the company's three networks: Univisión, TeleFutura and Galavision, as well as its online and other platforms.

Fernandez joins Univisión from Spanish Radio Television Corp., Spain's leading broadcast company.

Mexico City-based Televisa has long produced much of Univisión's content, but their deal expires in 2017. In contrast, rival Telemundo produces the majority of its own shows.
