

BOLLYWOBBLE: Though the production team for “Ra.One,” a forthcoming Bollywood movie starring the genre’s preeminent celebrity **Shahrukh Khan**, has pulled out of its downtown Miami base, half of the film could still be shot here. “It isn’t dead,” said film Producer and Bollywood Hollywood CEO **Prashant Shah** in an e-mail from London. But “we had to pull out since the unions were demanding ‘none of their business’ queries.” Producers said they scrapped Miami because unions demanded wages much higher than what Indian crews are paid when shooting in the US. The Miami portion of production was to be budgeted at \$3.5 million for 30 days of shooting. The project was expected to create about 1,500 jobs.
