Univisión to show programs on YouTube

LOS ANGELES — (AP) — Univisión, the biggest Hispanic broadcaster in the United States, said Monday its shows will be coming to YouTube in the new year.

Videos to be made available include the talk show *El Show de Cristina*, based in Miami, the variety show *Don Francisco Presenta*, and the murder thriller series, *Mujeres Asesinas*.

But they won't include popular telenovelas from its Mexican production partner Grupo Televisa because of a legal dispute preventing either of them from putting Televisa content on the Internet in the United States.

Univisión has the exclusive right to broadcast Televisamade shows in the United States through 2017.

Kevin Conroy, president of Univisión Interactive Media, said it is up to the two companies to agree on terms for how to stream shows online in the United States.

YouTube, the online video site of Google Inc., will share advertising revenue with Univisión Communications after content begins appearing early in the first quarter of next year.
